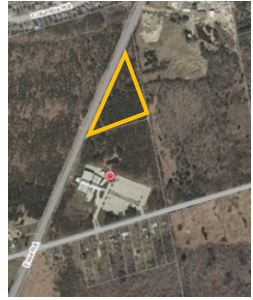
4 ways to get involved:

6.4 Acres

Member Vote



It was with vision that God led Emmanuel to purchase the 6.4 acres of land adjoining this property. That was in 2007 and during that time this land has appreciated considerably.

The Emmanuel leadership has been prayerfully considering what role this piece of land will have in our future. In the fall of 2015 a committee began meeting to investigate the potential opportunities of utilizing the land. The committee consisted of: Ted Handy, Dave Brubacher, Milt Carr, Ross Cotton, Mike Gartner, Lance Johnson, John Whelan, and Donna Winfield.

After a series of meetings, which included bringing in outside experts, the committee presented its recommendation to the Elders that the land should be sold if the church could realize approximately \$400,000 per acre from the sale. The majority of the proceeds would be used to reduce the outstanding debt, and the remainder would be available for ministry initiatives in support of Emmanuel's vision. On March 6th, 2016 the Elders presented the options at a special Church Family meeting.

As a result of this prayerful and considerate process, the board is putting forward the following motions to the membership to be **voted on June 5 and 12, 2016.**

Motion 1:

That the 6.4 acre parcel of land adjoining the church be offered for sale.

Motion 2:

That the Board be given the authority to negotiate the disposal of the land on behalf of the church utilizing the expertise of the 6.4 committee.
